DAY 01 APRIL 18 Sunday **Depart USA**

Departure from United States. Meals served during flight.

DAY 02 APRIL 19 Monday - **Tel Aviv**

Arrive at Tel Aviv's Ben Gurion Airport and meet our guide who will welcome us to the Land of the Bible and escort us throughout our stay in Israel. Optional meeting and worship with Dugit Messianic congregation in Tel Aviv (subject to arrival time). Dinner & overnight in Tel Aviv Hotel

DAY 03 APRIL 20 Tuesday - **Joseph Project, Caesarea, Mt. Carmel, Armageddon**

This morning visit the **Joseph Project** in Rosh HaAyin and tour and have a presentation of the new facility. Continue to **Caesarea** at the Mediterranean Sea which was the Roman capital of Judah during the reign of Herod the Great. Continue on to Mt Carmel where Elijah held a contest against the false prophets of Ba'al. Drive via **Armageddon** to see the ancient tel. Continue to the shores of the Sea of Galilee. In the evening you may stroll on the promenade in downtown Tiberias. For those who wish, we can visit the Diamond Factory. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Tiberias.



DAY 04 APRIL 21 Wednesday - **The Galilee and Golan Heights**

Enjoy a most memorable Boat Ride to **Capernaum** and visit the center of Yeshua's ministry in the Galilee. Drive to **Mount of Beatitudes**; "Blessed are the peacemakers for they shall be called sons of God" (Mt. 5:9). Continue north to **Hazor**, one of the oldest archaeological sites in Israel. Here Joshua fought against Jabin. Hazor was later fortified by Solomon. Return to Tiberias via the **Golan Heights** where you will enjoy a **jeep ride** in this scenic part of

Israel. This evening have the opportunity for an **Immersion service** at Yardenit. Dinner and overnight at the hotel in Tiberias.



DAY 05 APRIL 22 Thursday – **Rafting on the Jordan, Massada and Dead Sea**

This morning enjoy a fun and challenging experience **kayak rafting** on the Jordan River. Departing the North, pass Jericho and visit **Massada** – Herod's Palace overlooking the Dead Sea where the zealots made their last stand against the might of Rome in 73 AD. ascend to Jerusalem. Overnight and dinner at your hotel on the **Dead Sea**.

DAY 06 APRIL 23 Friday - **Beersheva, Revivim, Sde Boker, Avdat, and HaMakhtesh Crater**

Enjoy free time today for a dip in the Dead Sea or spa treatments or explore the northern Negev region of Israel when you visit the ancient tel at **Beersheva**, a Negev agricultural center at **Revivim**, Ben Gurion's grave at **Sde Boker**, the Wilderness of Sin at **Avdat**, and finally a scenic overlook of the **HaMakhtesh Crater**. Return for overnight and dinner at your hotel on the Dead Sea.

DAY 07 APRIL 24 Saturday – **Jerusalem**

Depart the Dead Sea this morning and visit **Qumran** where the Dead Sea scrolls were found. View Jerusalem for the first time when you visit the **Mount of Olives** and view the entire city. Proceed to the **Garden of Gethsemane** and the **Church of all Nations**. Visit the **Israel Museum**, where we will see the Shrine of the Book where the Dead Sea Scrolls are displayed and the scale Model of Ancient Jerusalem. Drive to Overnight and dinner at the hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 08 APRIL 25 Sunday – **Mt. Zion, City of David and Israel Museum**

We will enter the **Old City** via the Dung Gate. See the

important excavations taking place at the **Western Wall** and the Southern Temple Staircase at the **Davidson Center**. See the **Temple Mount** where Abraham was to sacrifice Isaac and where the Dome of the Rock and El Aqsa Mosque now stand. Walk through the **Cardo**; see the original Roman street and the amazing remains of the massive wall built by Hezekiah. Visit the **Temple Institute**. We will visit the **Rabbinical Tunnel** which takes us underground to the base of the Temple Mount. Conclude your day with a visit to the Jewish Quarter and the Jewish Quarter Museum. In the museum, you will learn how the **Jewish Quarter** was under siege for over 150 days from December 1947 until May 1948. When the Independence War broke out 200 fighters from the Hagana, Irgun, and Lechi protected the quarter.

DAY 09 APRIL 26 Monday - Mt. Zion, City of David and Hezekiah's Tunnel

Visit **Mt. Zion** to see the Tomb of King David. Next visit the **City of David** and walk through the excavations dating back to the time of the conquest of the Jebusite city by King David. See (and walk through if you desire) **Hezekiah's Tunnel** and the newly discovered Pool of Siloam. In the afternoon visit **Ammunition Hill**, the site of one of the most strategic battles of the Six Day War. Overnight and dinner at the hotel in Jerusalem.

DAY 10 APRIL 27 Tuesday - Herzel Center, Yad Vashem and Genesis Land

After breakfast visit **Herzl Center and Museum**. The new Herzl Museum is a sophisticated audiovisual display that recounts the life story of Herzl - his aspirations, disappointments and turbulent personal journey. The experience it offers presents this extraordinary man both as a historical figure from the past, and as an inspiring visionary of the future whose dreams challenge Zionists today as they did over a century ago. We will visit **Yad Vashem**, the Holocaust Memorial Museum. Farewell dinner in **Genesis Land** (Eretz Bereshit) in Abraham's Tent, we will enjoy a trip back in time. Transfer to the airport for your flight home this evening.

DAY 11 APRIL 28 Wednesday - Return

Larry Feldman, was raised in a Conservative Jewish home in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania. He came to faith in Yeshua, the Messiah, after receiving his B.A. in Psychology from Temple University in 1970, whereupon he felt the calling of God to prepare for service in full-time ministry. He attended the Moody Bible Institute in Chicago, Illinois, and received a diploma in the Advanced Studies Program in 1974. He led a Messianic congregation in Brooklyn, New York for the next five years. In 1979, he enrolled at the Dallas Theological Seminary where he received a Master of Theology degree in Semitic Languages and Old Testament Studies. Larry has founded six Messianic congregations, including Shuvah Yisrael. He lives with his wife, Fran, and their two daughters, Rachel and Rebekah, in Irvine.

Today Paul's ministry is as worldwide as his music. "God's grace is truly amazing," Paul says, "as we have ministered in more than thirty nations, recorded in three languages, and have witnessed thousands set free by Messiah empowered worship and praise."

One of the aspects of this ministry that may not be apparent at first glance is Paul's commitment to the marriage of music, ministry, and acts of mercy. "As we travel to third world nations we seek to bring a larger expression of the kingdom of God in a practical way. Dr. Paul Williams staffs free medical clinics to minister to the needs of the poor; Paul Cuny brings MarketPlace Ministry to the business community; Messiah Company brings the beauty of movement to worship, while Integrity Worship artists stir the hearts to joyful song."

Paul sees his calling to the Church and the Jewish community and to build bridges of reconciliation between them. His latest recording for Integrity, *The Watchman*, is a stirring call to the Body of Christ worldwide to take up their place on the walls of their lives, congregations, cities, and nations—to be faithful, prayerful, and watchful during what he calls "this most prophetic hour."

The Watchman was recorded "live" on Yom Kippur at Cornerstone Church in San Antonio with Pastor John Hagee. "Yom Kippur, or the Day of Atonement," he explains, "was the one day of the year that the high priest was allowed to come before the presence of God, and only with blood, making atonement for himself and all Israel. I believe this recording will carry that anointing in a very special way and will sweep many into the kingdom of God."

Joel Chernoff is one the pioneers of Messianic music. For 20 years he has been lead singer and songwriter for the music group LAMB. Lamb, whose recordings have sold over 600,000 copies, has produced 14 Messianic recordings many of which have reached Top 10 status on the contemporary religious charts. He has also recently recorded and released two new solo national recordings from Galilee of the Nations entitled, *The Restoration of Israel* and *Come Dance With Me*. His most recent release, also from Galilee of the Nations and distributed by Integrity Music in 2005 is a new Lamb recording titled *The Sacrifice*.

Besides his continuing recording and singing ministry, Joel is serving as Vice President of the International Messianic Jewish Alliance and as General Secretary of the Messianic Jewish Alliance of America or MJAA. The International Messianic Jewish Alliance is the largest affiliation of Messianic Jews in the world today with over 20 national member alliances. The Messianic Jewish Alliance of America is the largest of these 18 national alliances.

Joel Chernoff also serves as Chairman of the MJAA Joseph Project which has shipped over \$80 million worth of humanitarian aid to Israel over the last 5 years.
